We have modified the schedule to match the school year more closely, starting in September and finishing in May.

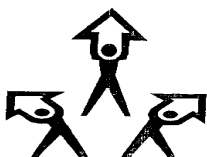
We anticipate being selective in choosing the 2011 Leadership Kernersville class. We anticipate more applications than the 18-20 people accepted into the class.
