



Dear Applicant,

We are excited to have you apply for the thirteenth year of **Kernersville Connections**. This group of young adults will connect the youth of our community to businesses belonging to the Chamber of Commerce. This is a 1 year program.

The selection committee, comprised of community leaders, will interview candidates and select 15 -20 individuals for this honor by **June 6**. Interview times will be staggered before or after school different days at Kernersville high schools. Afternoon appointments will be available for career center students unable to interview in the mornings. We will contact you with your interview time.

The group will serve in conjunction with the Chamber of Commerce Ambassadors, an adult group of business leaders. The group will represent the Chamber at functions like the Spring Folly, area business ribbon cuttings, Business After/Before Hours events, the KMAZING Race (Sophomores only) and the Annual Chamber Banquet (Juniors only). Connections members will act as event hosts.

Required attendance will include **a mandatory initial meeting** to be held in **August**. We only ask that members commit to attend a minimum of four functions throughout the year in addition to the mandatory appearances at the annual banquet (Juniors only), KMAZING Race (Sophomores only), Chamber Board meeting and Spring Folly. Graduation from the program is dependent upon the completion of these events.

Some functions may be during school hours. These would be completely optional and based on school and parent permission to attend. The Chamber's Ambassadors will chaperone all events.

Students will be required to communicate with the Chamber of Commerce on a regular basis throughout the year. **Parents will not be allowed to schedule events for their student and communicate with the Chamber staff**. Those Connections students that will be selected are young leaders in their community and will be trusted with the responsibility of managing their time.

Requirements include:

- Parental permission
- An overall B- grade average
- 2015-2016 Sophomore or Junior in high school.
- Kernersville resident **or** resident of close, surrounding rural areas with an obvious connection to Kernersville (such as Scouting, church affiliation, etc.), **or** attending a Kernersville high school

- Two completed recommendation forms as specified on application.
- If chosen, \$30 uniform fee for shirts to be worn with khaki pants, skirts, or shorts as appropriate. Or, uniform shirts may be obtained from past members.
- If chosen, must provide own transportation to and from events.
- If chosen, must be willing to sign an agreement to represent the Chamber with professional conduct.

The benefits are immeasurable to the 20 members chosen to participate. Not only will this be a high-profile position within our community, learning leadership skills and networking with area businesses will provide further motivation to succeed in school and in life. Also, selection will provide an impressive addition to high school resumes, important for college or job applications.
