Award Categories:

Small Business Person of the Year	Presented to an individual for excellence in business management, accomplishments and/or development. Company must have less than 100 employees and show business stability or growth (financial, number of employees or output of products or services).
Minority Small Business Person of the Year	Presented to an individual who is either an ethnic minority or a female for excellence in business management, accomplishments and/or development. Company must have less than 100 employees and show business stability or growth (financial, number of employees or output of products or services.).
Small Business Advocate of the Year	Presented to an individual who makes a sincere effort to help other business to succeed.
Duke Energy Citizenship & Service Award	Presented to a company for its community involvement and service to the community over a sustained period of time. The company should also demonstrate some or all of the following business values: integrity, stewardship, inclusion, initiative, teamwork and accountability.
